A KNITS N KNACKS PATTERN DESIGNED BY ATHENA FORBES

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I wanted to make this hat because... Screw You 2020! 'Nuff said!

(Also the pattern on the sides remind me of covid balls haha)


For more detailed instructions on gauge and how to work the brim, please purchase any of my following patterns: Moosey Slouchy, Kodiak Kisses, Maple Pride, or Stronger.

Materials: -Patons Classic Wool or similar #4 worsted weight yarn.

-4.5mm (US 7) for brim & 5mm (US 8) for color work, 16" circulars and/or DPNs.

Notes: $oxed{\mathbb{Q}}$ - Knit this stitch in the background color of the square, and then wrap/carry your non working/float yarn around the working yarn. -CC= contrast color.

- The chart is repeated 2 times around the hat. The light grey st on the chart is worked as a CC on the first repeat of the chart and MC on the last repeat.





Decreases: Work the decreases from any of the above patterns or use these as SOON as the chart is done to have the color work go up into the decreases.

- 1- k5, k2tog, k2cc, k3, k2cc, k2tog, k4 wrap k2, k2tog, k1, k2cc, k3, k2cc, k1, k2tog, k3 wrap k2, k2tog,
- 2- k3 wrap k1, k2tog, k1, k2cc, k1, k2cc, k1, k2tog, k2 wrap k20, k2tog, k2, k2cc, k1, k2cc, k1, k2tog, k2 wrap k2, k2tog, wrap.
- 3- k3, k2tog, wrap, k2, k3cc, k1, k2tog, k3, wrap, k2tog, k3, k3cc, k1, k2tog, k3, k2tog, wrap.
- 4- k2, k2tog, k5", k2tog, k2, k2tog, k6, k2tog, k2, k2tog.
- 5- k1, k2tog, k4, k2tog, k1, k2tog, k5, k2tog, k1, k2tog.
- 6- k2tog, k3, k2tog, k2tog, k4, k2tog, k2tog.
- 7- k2tog, k1, k2tog, k5, k2tog,
- 8- k2tog, k2tog, k3, k2tog,
- 9- k2tog around.

Finishing: Used the CC starting tail yarn to work a duplicate st and fix the jog at the bottom the tall 0 as pictured to the right
